### What do I need to sit for the exam in CT?

- 120 semester hours
- Bachelors degree
- 46 semester hours in accounting and related subjects such as finance, business law or economics; of which at least 24 semester hours must be in accounting

## 2. Obtain Certification

### What do I need to gain licensure in CT?

- 150 semester hours
- Pass the CPA Exam
- Pass the Ethics Exam
- 2 years of experience required
- Pay \$135 application fee

### What experience do I need?

- Public accounting experience is the easiest to verify (25% attest work; 75% other accounting functions). Industry experience is more difficult to verify and 100% must be in the internal audit function.
- Experience must be supervised by CPA
- Employer will fill out experience form
- Can be fulfilled before, during or after passing the CPA Exam
