Dues Structure and Billing Classes

**Billing codes are based upon your status as of March 31, 2018.
If you fit into more than one category, the higher dues rate prevails.**

5) CPA Firm Owner – \$310

Any Connecticut firm owner who is a Certified or Associate (Non-CPA) Member engaged in the practice of public accounting.

4) CPA (Non-Owner) – \$250

Any Certified Member who is:

- (a) An individual employed in any capacity in Connecticut -OR-
- (b) A resident employed outside of Connecticut -OR-
- (c) An equivalent of a CPA from another country

3) Associate (Non-Owner) – \$250

Any Associate (Non-CPA) Member who is:

- (a) An individual employed in any capacity in Connecticut -OR-
- (b) A resident employed outside of Connecticut

2) Fully Retired – \$125

Any Certified or Associate (Non-CPA) Member fully retired from all employment

1) Non-Resident – \$125

Any Certified or Associate (Non-CPA) Member who is a non-resident employed outside of Connecticut

Dues to the CTCPA are not deductible as a charitable contribution but may be deductible as an ordinary and necessary business expense. However, a portion of dues (10 percent for the year ending March 31, 2019) is not deductible to the extent that CTCPA engages in lobbying.
