Following Rules & Completing Classwork	Student consistently follows rules within the classroom. Behavior has never been a concern. Student occasionally does not follow rules within the classroom or has been spoken to about classroom behavior. Student needs consistent reminders to focus on classwork during the time allotted and has been caught doing other things on more than two occasions.	Student often does not follow rules within the classroom or has been spoken to about classroom behavior more than once. Student is often off-task and does not complete classwork assignments during class on a regular basis.
Prepared for Class	Student is prepared for class each day with his/her textbook and workbook.	Student was not prepared with his/her textbook or workbook during one class period.	Student was not prepared with his/her textbook or workbook during 2-3 class periods.	Student was not prepared with his/her textbook or workbook more than 3 times.
Participation	Student participates daily by raising his/her hand.	Student participates by raising his/her hand at least twice per week.	Student participates only when called on by the teacher.	Student is often unprepared to participate, even when called on by the teacher.
Groupwork	Student is an asset to his/her group by staying on task and assisting other students with their work.	Student is an asset to his/her group by staying on task.	Student needs occasional reminders to stay on task when working in a group.	Student does not contribute towards group work and is a distraction to the group.
