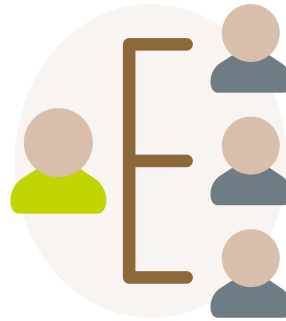

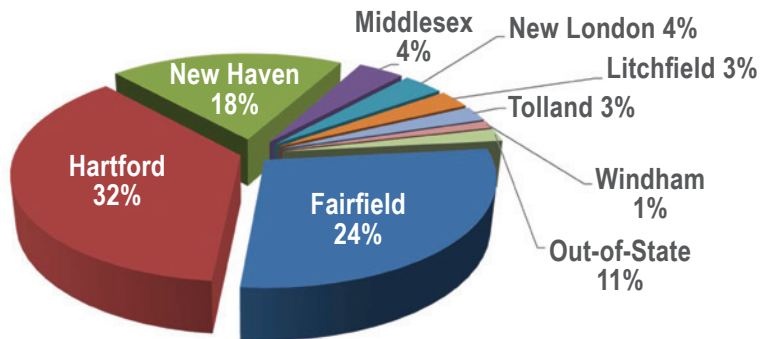

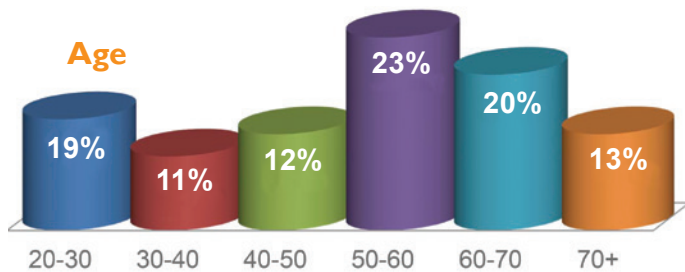
# Member Demographics



## Location by County

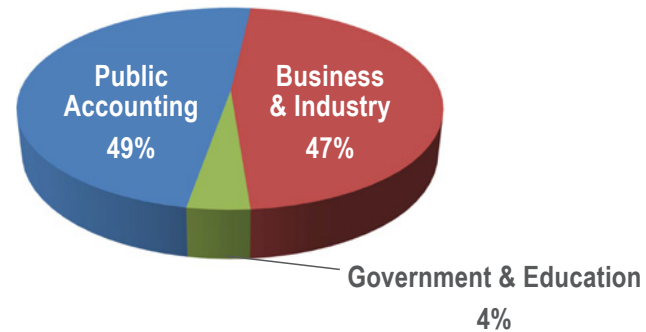

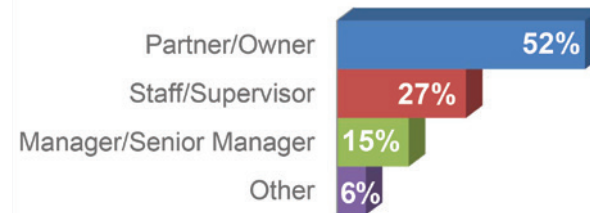
